OSU Black Faculty & Staff Association SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



The Black Faculty and Staff Association at Oklahoma State University has been awarding scholarships to continuing students for nearly 30 years. The awards are based on academic efforts, campus and community activity, financial need, and other outstanding characteristics exhibited by students. Award monies are dispersed evenly during the Fall and Spring semesters. Funding for these awards comes from the generous contributions of OSU Black faculty and staff.

Qualifications: Recipients of awards must meet the following criteria:

READ CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS.

- 1. An applicant must be a continuing undergraduate student who is at least a freshman (with a minimum of 12 hours completed at OSU) at time of application.
- Applicants must have at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA at Oklahoma State University.
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time at OSU for Fall 2018 prior to the release of funds.
- 4. Previous recipients of this award may be ranked lower than new applicants (non-recipients).
- 5. Submit two reference letters; it is preferred that one be from an OSU faculty member who can address the applicant's academic qualifications, sense of responsibility and leadership potential. Those letters should be emailed directly from the faculty member to bfsa@okstate.edu.
- 6. All information should be in this form. Use correct grammar, punctuation and spelling.
- 7. Successful applicants are expected to attend the spring Honor awards ceremony upon request.
- 8. Email bfsa@okstate.edu with any questions.

Application Packet Checklist

Your email should have only four attachments:

- 1. This form filled out in its entirety
- 2. Your personal narrative
- 3. Updated resume
- 4. Your current unofficial transcript (pdf only) from OSU

When you email your application, put "BFSA scholarship application" in the subject line and send it from your official OSU campus email account. The name of each attached file should begin with your last name. Do NOT send multiple emails with your information. (Your recommendation letters should come directly from your references.)
